Identity In Christ (Law and Grace)

Give and work through expectations worksheet (optional if not married)

Teach:

What if change expectations to standard or rules or laws.

Nothing wrong with expectations, unless abused, like when someone not meet our expectations, we reject them.

Look at worksheet Law and Grace (read)

The Law - The system of performance (or behavior) that God set up to bless those who fulfill its requirements and to curse those who do not. (Deut. 28:1)

- Its foundation is the **10 Commandments**. (The codified law was given at Mt. Sinai, but the system itself began when man ate from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.)
- -It also includes the statutes and ordinances that follow it.
- -The law system is also the system every person operates from based on his/her own set of standards, not necessarily the Law of God.
- -It is an achieving system.

Grace - the system of faith (trust, dependence) which God has set up to bless those who are in Christ only because they are "in Christ".

- -Being blessed by God no longer depends on a Christian's performance or behavior.
- -A Christian cannot be cursed, judged, nor condemned by God because of performance or behavior.
- -The grace system is clearly explained in Ephesians (beginning with 1:3).
- -It is a **receiving** system.

Who is under the law system?

- 1. Every person born into this world.
- 2. All non-Christians. Romans 3:19
- 3. All who are in Adam.

When did every person enter into the law system?

Because we were all in Adam, we all entered into the law system the moment Adam ate from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. At that moment, we internalized the law system of being blessed for performing (or behaving) right and of being cursed for performing (or behaving) evil.

The law system can not

Give *life*. Gal. 3:21 Change your *identity*. Gal. 3:21, 6:15 Make you *righteous*, i.e. acceptable to God. Rom. 3:20

What then is the purpose of the Law?

- 1. To show non-Christians that their identity is that of a sinner. Rom. 3:20a
- 2. To show non-Christians that they need something greater than the law to have a relationship with God. In other words, they need Christ. Gal. 3:24-26

Is the Law bad?

No. The Law is actually holy, righteous and good. Romans 7:12 The sinner does not want to obey the Law nor can they because of their identity.

What does attempting to perform the Law produce?

Pride and **self-righteousness** for those who can perform it. (Phil. 3:6)

Guilt and **condemnation** for those who cannot perform it. (II Cor. 3:6-9, James 2:10)

Exhaustion and **Depression** for those who cannot perform it

Romans 7:5 (read) Law aroused sin.

We think rules are to control sin, but they arouse sin.

What is it like to be married to Mr. Law? Rom. 7:1-7

- 1. He always tells you what to do.
- 2. He always shows you where you have failed.
- 3. He never lifts a finger to help you.
- 4. You can never do enough to please him.
- 5. He is always perfect, always right.

Session 6

The Law was never meant to keep us from sinning.

Matthew 5:48 (read)

What is God's expectation? (perfect)

How does God accept us? On the basis of the law or are we under the law? On the basis of being not doing. On the basis of Grace. We are free to sin, but are no longer a slave to sin and do not want to sin.

Romans 7:6 (read)

We died to the Law, so we are not under law and should not put others under it.

All the world is run by laws, but you can't create morality. A person has to be transformed by the grace of God.

What is the one commandment that encapsulates the entire new covenant?

Love God and love people. (Mark 12:30-31)

What is the law of Christ?

Love Gal. 6:2, John 15:12

Why is understanding grace along with identity so important? Romans 5:17

- 1. It produces "victorious" Christian living.
- 2. It avoids license or legalism

It has been said that all behavior is to either gain acceptance or avoid rejection. Acceptance is the opposite of rejection. We are now accepted, because we are now in Christ and He in us.

God created us with this need to be loved and he fills it. When we are filled with God's love, we can Let others off the hook for filling that void. God only satisfies.

Fleshly acceptance is self-centered.

- -By Appearance, possessions, abilities, personality, and achievements.
- -By religious behaviors...quiet time, witnessing, not sinning, church, etc...

This is performance-based acceptance. It is focused on self and can only be done in the flesh.

This leads to legalism. Instead we need to accept others as God accepts us.

- 1. Relationship replaces regulations
- 2. Mirrors replaces microscopes look at self and not criticize others
- 3. Passion replaces performance we obey out of love relationship which avoids license

God's provision for acceptance is through Christ. We are given a new identity.

I am crucified with Christ and am a new creation (Gal 2:20 & 2Cor 5:17)

Ex. Discover oil story

Diagram of Messages: diagram top 8 coping, talk about how that is not you, it's the old you.

We need to focus our attention on beliefs (just like Beverly Hill Billies had to believe they were millionaires), that will change our emotions and behavior.

Look over My Changed Identity and Who I Am in Christ worksheets.


Challenge to memorize at least one verse.
