Concept Of (and Intimacy with) God

<u>Teach:</u> We all ask four questions: Who am I, Why am I Here, Who is God, and What is His purpose for me?

A.W. Tozer (1961, pp. 1-3) wrote: "What comes into our minds when we think about God is the most important thing about us. . . Were we able to extract from any man a complete answer to the question, 'What comes into your mind when you think about God?' we might predict with certainty the spiritual future of that man. . . Our real idea of God may lie buried under the rubbish of conventional religious notions and may require an intelligent and vigorous search before it is finally unearthed and exposed for what it is. Only after an ordeal of painful self probing are we likely to discover what we actually believe about God." - Knowledge of His Holiness

Our concept of God, our understanding or idea of God, is of crucial importance to fully expressing the Christ-life.

What Is Your Concept of God? A Concept is a "notion that leads to a judgment".

- -Concepts control us more than truth
- -Our concepts are often based upon error

Why do you think you believe what you believe?

Five Hidden Sources of Distortion

- -The Inter-generational Cycle *Distortions passed down through generations Ex. pharasees*
- -Attribution Experiences and events cause us to attribute things to God
- -Parental Projections "God is like my Father" (or whoever is the authority)

Missing or preoccupied (where is God)
Angry
Demanding (perfectionism)
Too busy (God not have time, need attention)
Uncaring (God is apathetic)

-Self-Projections -We project feelings about our self onto how we view God -Early Religious Training and Experiences - Church, SS, Media, and unusual experiences may produce legalistic, shame-based, or guilt motivated view of God

Ex. Church sign – work for God, and He'll work for you!

My Personal Concept Of God

Give "Who is God Worksheet", pray, and work through

Use the questionnaire on "Who Is God?"

Record your first thought

Record your "true" impressions, not religious answers

Ask God to reveal your mental **and** emotional impressions of Himself.

What are your FEELINGS telling you about God?

Three false concepts about God

- -Harsh Judge God's out to get me. "I believe in God for the bad stuff"
- -Divine Employer "God has me on a time clock and I'm working for Him If I do well, He loves me, but if I do badly, He hates me."
- -Distant Deity He's 'out there somewhere' watching me.
- -Santa Clause tell Him what you want

Heb 6:17-18 Wherein God, willing more abundantly to show unto the heirs of promise the **immutability** of his counsel, confirmed *it* by an oath: That by two **immutable** things, in which *it was impossible for God to lie*, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us: (read from v. 14 – Abraham's promise to multiply and be blessed is fulfilled)

God Loves Us (Zeph 3:14-17)

God wants Intimacy with us

"Very few people today find Jesus interesting as a person or of vital relevance to the course of their actual lives. He is not generally regarded as a real-life personality who deals with real-life issues but is thought to be concerned with some feathery realm other than the one we must deal with, and must deal with now. And frankly, he is not taken to be a person of much ability." (Dallas Willard, The Divine Conspiracy)

The Story of Eli and Samuel [1 Samuel 3:1-10]

"We have become too familiar with a God we do not know."

"Today the heart of God is an open wound of love. He aches over our distance and preoccupation ... He weeps over our obsession with muchness and manyness. He longs for our presence." (Richard Foster)

Intimacy with God - "enjoying, living out of, and being transformed by the adventure of an ever-increasing experiential knowledge of God."

Without intimacy

<u>Busyness</u> substitutes for meaning, <u>efficiency</u> substitutes for creativity, and <u>functional</u> relationships substitute for love.

We live from <u>ought (I ought to do this)</u> rather than from <u>desire (I want to do this)</u>.

Communion with God is replaced by <u>activity for God</u>.

<u>Management</u> substitutes for mystery — no time is given to explore the deep questions of the heart, dreams, passions, fears and wounds.

Our heart does not respond to principles and programs; it doesn't seek efficiency. It seeks <u>passion</u>.

"It is by the heart that God is perceived [known] and not by reason ... so that is what faith is: God perceived by the heart." (Oswald Chambers)

Intimacy Is An Aspect Of The Nature of God.

God designed man for intimacy (relationship); it is His life-long pursuit.

"And the Lord God said, 'It is not good that man should be alone. I will make him a helper comparable to him." (Genesis 2:18, NKJV)

This was said before Adam sinned. Even in a perfect environment, man was designed for intimacy.

What are your enemies to intimacy with God?

One is probably your concept of Him, so let's begin...

Understanding the True God

Religion gives the idea of God Theology interprets and organizes the content Philosophy establishes a relation to man's experience Bibliology is the study of God's Word

Separate any negative experiences in your past from truth

Especially experiences involving parents Forgiveness process may be needed

Make a conscious decision

To start a new and real concept of God Learn the scriptural truths about God's character

In prayer, invite God to be your Father of choice.

Approach God as a child

Challenge: obtain an accountability/prayer partner




